The Medicine

Long after ‘old-fashioned’ antifungals — like Tolnaftate and Undecylenic Acid — were formulated, a new class of medication, with broader-spectrum effectiveness against more types of infections, was synthesized by a German chemist. Clotrimazole was created.

It became something of a wonder-drug, safely and effectively treating a variety of fungal conditions — under nails, between toes, ‘athlete’s foot’, jock itch, ringworm, yeast infections, ear and throat infections and more.

The Food & Drug Administration approved Clotrimazole for use because of its clinically-proven effectiveness, and its well-documented safe use over many years — worldwide — with side effects rarely ever occurring. So safe, it is approved for use on children under age 2, and rated “B” for pregnant women, unlike Tolnaftate (“C”).

What’s new?

In the past, liquid antifungals were water or alcohol-based — inexpensive, easy ways to deliver their old-fashioned medicines to the affected area. But those liquids offer no additional or inherent benefits. To the contrary, alcohol applied to the skin is not ordinarily recommended.

Our scientists use a newer process to make Clotrimazole soluble in Essential Oils with a history of antimicrobial, antiseptic, antifungal, conditioning and penetrating activity.

The resulting combination is ClotrimazOil® — first with the broad-spectrum antifungal power of Clotrimazole, in an exclusive, penetrating, Essential Oils carrier formula. It is now recommended by doctors as a primary therapy, or in combination with oral drugs and laser nail treatments.

The Delivery

ClotrimazOil® is delivered to affected surfaces in a proprietary Essential Oils formula, including Tea Tree, Jojoba, Peppermint, Sweet Almond and others.

Tea Tree Oil

Effective in vitro against dermatophytes found on the skin. Tea tree oil has a history of antifungal, antiseptic, and antimicrobial activity. In studies, it has been shown to stop bacteria, mold and fungal growth. It is produced from the leaves of a tree native to Southeast Queensland and the Northeast coast of New South Wales, Australia, where it has been used medicinally for thousands of years.



Jojoba Oil

Is the liquid wax that is produced in the seed of the Jojoba plant — a shrub, which is native to southern Arizona, southern California and northwestern Mexico. Jojoba oil is a known fungicide. It is very similar to the sebum oil produced naturally by human glands, resulting in its popularity in many skin-care products.



Peppermint Oil

Peppermint has a long tradition of medicinal use, with archaeological evidence placing its use at least as far back as ten thousand years. Peppermint contains Menthol, which is thought to activate cold-sensitive receptors in skin tissue, which is the primary source of the cooling sensation that follows its topical application.



Sweet Almond Oil

From a species of trees native to the Middle East and South Asia, sweet almond oil is obtained from the dried kernel of sweet almonds. The oil has long been popular as an emollient.



Common Questions & Answers

How do I use ClotrimazOil®?

Apply a thin-coating to affected surfaces twice daily — morning and night. Use sparingly — this is a concentrated formula. Allow to dry.

How long does it take to dry?

Only minutes — fastest if one applies only a THIN layer to the affected area.

Will it work on my nails?

Your doctor might recommend ClotrimazOil® for application on, around and under nails, where reachable with the applicator brush — to help improve their appearance.

How long will it take to work?

Fungal infections are notoriously difficult to eliminate. You should see results after a few weeks of use, with continued improvement over time. If your doctor has recommended ClotrimazOil® for fungal nails, it generally takes about 1 year for them to re-grow. Keep using ClotrimazOil®, even after your symptoms are gone — fungus will return if not thoroughly treated.



How long will a bottle of ClotrimazOil® last?

3-6 months, depending on the amount used daily, and the size of the affected areas it is applied to.

What else can I do about my fungal infection?

Change shoes and socks daily. Use FungaSoap® daily to wash your feet. Dry toes carefully. Wear socks and shoes that keep feet dry. Use medications your doctor recommends to control fungal infections. Disinfect your shoes to prevent re-infection.

Can pregnant women use ClotrimazOil®?

Pregnancy Rated “B”. Ask your doctor, just to be sure.

Where can I buy ClotrimazOil®?

ClotrimazOil® is available only from healthcare professionals. It is not sold in stores or online.

Why does the package state “not effective on scalp or nails”?
